### New statue depicts dead Prince Harry

LONDON, Sept. 27 (UPI) -- An art installation to be unveiled at London's Trafalgar Hotel next month depicts Prince Harry as a soldier killed in Iraq.

"Iraq War Memorial featuring the Death of Prince Harry, the Martyr of Maysan Province" shows the brother of the future king of England as the symbolic fallen hero in a memorial honoring the brave at heart -- those willing but unable to serve in the Iraq conflict, Bridge Art Fair has announced.

Prince Harry planned to serve in Iraq as a soldier in the coalition forces but was kept home after specific threats to kidnap or kill him were made.

The statue features Harry laid out before the Union Jack with pennies over his eyes and his head resting on the Bible as he clutches a bloodied flag of Wales and holds a cameo locket of Princess Diana to his heart, while a vulture perches on his boot.

Harry's head is earless, referring to threats from militia leaders to send the prince back to his grandmother "without his ears."

A bronze casting of Harry's "severed ears" also set for display at the Trafalgar Hotel will be sold on eBay.

The memorial will be unveiled Oct. 11.
